

Physical development

This term, the children will be developing their fundamental movement skills through a range of fun athletic activities. They will practise running, jumping, hopping and skipping, helping to build coordination, balance and confidence in movement.

The children will also develop their ball skills, focusing on improving precision, control and accuracy through throwing, catching and aiming activities.

Maths

This term, the children will explore subtraction, doubling, sharing and grouping, as well as odd and even numbers. They will also deepen their understanding of previous learning through patterns and spatial reasoning activities.

Knowledge & Understanding of the world

This term, we will be exploring sea animals and their habitats and where in the world they can be found.

We will also investigate what is polluting our seas and consider what we can do to help protect the oceans, the animals that live in them and their habitats.

School Value

Our value this term is courage. We will think about what this value means and how to show it. Jill Rowe will visit weekly to share Bible stories and help us reflect on this value.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)

Jigsaw Jenie will be helping us to explore 'changing me' this term. She will help us explore the changes we face and how to deal with them. We will also be thinking about us 'changing' to Leopards in September.

Literacy

We will use our phonic knowledge to write labels, captions and simple sentences. Children will be encouraged to write independently, using sound mats to support them.

Our daily phonics sessions will focus on: wh, ph, ay, a-e, a, e-e, ie and ea.

Communication and language

We will continue to share stories as a class and encourage the children to ask questions about what they have heard. We will also learn and use new vocabulary linked to our topic.

Expressive arts

We will continue to sing a range of songs and rhymes in school, as well as select our own resources to create imaginative models. We will also experiment with colour and texture to create sea-themed paintings.
